**PRESS REPORT**

A winning sequence of 5 consecutive ends by each of the Northants rinks in the middle section of the game crafted a lead by 5 shots at the 15 end mark. Jim McKee's rink concluded the game 12 shots adrift of Nicky Brett's rink leaving Gearey (ahead 24-8) defending a 4 shot cushion overall playing the last end. Hunts skip Ean Morton struck the head with his final delivery to create a lie of 3 shots but not enough to force an extra end.
