The Scheme, under the auspices of the English Bowls Youth Development Scheme is assisting in the running of the National School of Excellence to be held at Northampton & District Indoor Bowling Club, on **Sunday, 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2008**, commencing at 9.30 a.m.

The National Finals follow the many County Schools of Excellence held around the Country, and then the qualifiers coming through the Regional Finals. Supporters of young people playing bowls are very welcome to attend this event, when they can be assured of some high quality play.

So far as the County Scheme is concerned a new Secretary has been appointed. He is Eric Norton, of Rushden BC, and he takes over the role from Acting Secretary Andy Purcell. The local scheme is currently arranging its Indoor competitions, and also the County School of Excellence which will be held at Northampton & District IBC in January, 2009.
