**PRESS REPORT**

### **NORTHAMPTONSHIRE INDOOR BOWLING ASSOCIATION – TOUR TO PORTSMOUTH**

The Annual week-end Tour of Northamptonshire Indoor Bowling Association got under way early Friday morning with the party of 48 bowlers travelling by coach to Southsea, Hampshire, with the prospect of 6 matches, two on each day, of 6 rinks each. The party comprised of President Mick Pullen, Rushden IBC; Senior Vice-President Keith Howlett, Desborough IBC; Junior Vice-President Brian Langton, Kettering Lodge IBC; plus 4 former Presidents and the County Secretary Brian Sherwood, Senior Team Manager John Haines, Match Secretary Richard Somerton.

At the conclusion of the Tour President Mick Pullen was delighted to record a clean sweep of wins which started his year in office on a very promising note. The details of each match are as follows:
